Plastics Business Article — Spring, 2007

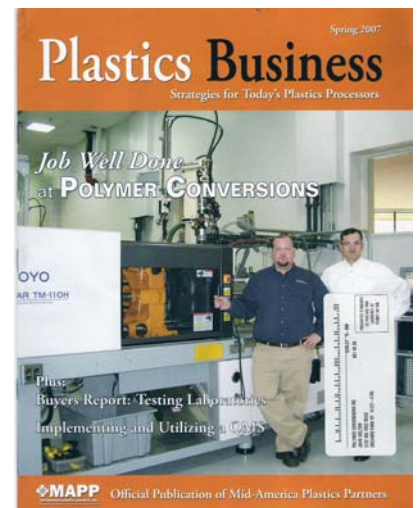
MAPP, (mid-America plastics partners, Inc), has developed a publication called “Plastics Business; Strategies for Today’s Plastics Processors”.
